- Fanny Ollas: Fusing ceramics and fake fur, Fanny Ollas creates the series "Pet Me," blurring the boundaries between functional object, sculpture, and design. These whimsical vases evoke both comfort and joy, like furry friends waiting to be petted.

- Amanda Malm: Amanda Malm's series, "Soft And Hard Feelings Floating In Thin Air," is a visual exploration of the human mind's complex emotions. Combining glass fusing, clay, and acrylics on canvas, her art captures the limitless nature of creativity.

- Lisa Vaccino: Through her series "Glitter Litter," Lisa Vaccino transforms random objects into colorful centerpieces, using air-drying clay and acrylic paint. Her "ugly-cute," whimsical creations find inspiration in the beauty of everyday life.

- Josefin Tolstoy: Showcasing the series "Curvy Straight Lines," Josefin Tolstoy's geometric, calm, and colorful artworks reflect her enduring need for creativity. Her use of acrylic and mortar on cotton canvas, framed with raw or whitewashed Swedish pine, adds depth and character to her pieces.
